Congratulations also to the Environmental Action Team who, along with the Environmental Committee, won our school a **2018-19 Environmental Grant for Waste Reduction and Recycling**, from the Onkaparinga Council. Australia used to be one of the best countries in the world when it came to waste. However, more recently, we haven't been doing so well. In fact, Australia is now one of the biggest producers of trash in the world with 41 million tonnes of rubbish created every year. Half of that goes to landfill where it can't be recycled.
